



SIGNAL SCHOLARSHIPS FOR SHIFT

These scholarships were established in 2016 to assist students of high academic calibre to undertake tertiary study through SIGNAL, the South Island ICT Grad School.

Regulations

1. The awards shall be known as the SIGNAL Shift Scholarships.
2. Up to eight scholarships will be awarded annually to full time students, registered for the SIGNAL Shift Programme through a SITA partner organisation.
3. To be eligible for the scholarship applicants shall:
 - (a) Have gained a bachelor degree or equivalent
 - (b) Be granted admission to the SIGNAL Shift programme (contact info@signal.ac.nz for more information)
4. Each scholarship shall be tenable for the minimum time required to complete the programme and shall comprise the following:
 - (a) An emolument of \$2,500, to be paid by direct credit to a bank account nominated by the student, subsequent to enrolment in a SIGNAL Shift qualification.
5. The scholarships will be awarded by the Director on the recommendation of a selection committee, which shall comprise:
 - (a) The Director, SIGNAL or nominee; and
 - (b) The Programme Director(s) for Shift
6. The criteria for the award shall be:
 - (a) Academic merit
 - (b) Potential for academic success
7. A subset of the scholarships may be reserved for priority groups these groups include:
 - (a) Women
 - (b) Maori
 - (c) Pasifika
7. The Scholarships may be held with any other award unless the rules of the other award preclude it.
8. For the purposes of these regulations an award includes a scholarship, bursary, prize or fellowship.
